

Motorcycle Accident Response Seminar.

You will learn that a Trauma First Aid Kit is more useful than an ordinary small First Aid Kit because of the contents, especially scissors and gauze materials

An accident, in itself, is a very traumatic experience. Therefore, we need to respond immediately and correctly in order to offer proper assistance. We need to stop as safely and quickly as possible and make sure we are out of harm's way.

When it is over everyone needs to go someplace and talk about what just happened. Check each other for shock. It is very important that you do not keep what just happened inside. Hopefully you will never have to deal with an accident scene. However, if you do, you will have the knowledge to do so


